IBIS members provide contact details on joining and these details are only held by Officers of the Society, the Membership Secretary primarily, the Treasurer and Chair, for the purpose of communication i.e. circulating Studies in Illustration, Journals, occasional papers and organising events. This data is stored securely and we treat this data with the utmost care and confidentiality and will never share your information with third parties.

If you do not wish to receive any communication from us and you would like us to delete all of your information entirely, please let the Membership Secretary know.
